<b>How much home instruction</b>	“number of days and length of time sufficient to continue the student’s academic progress and dependent upon the student’s ability to participate”	“one-on-one instruction for no fewer than 10 hours per week on three separate days of the week <b>and</b> no fewer than 10 hours per week of additional guided-learning experiences.”	At least 10 hours per week. The 10 hours of instruction per week shall be accomplished in at least three visits on at least three separate days
<b>Limitations</b>	For students with IEPs, when home instruction will exceed 30 consecutive school days in a school year, the IEP team shall convene a	None	Maximum of 60 calendar days, at which time renewal of the notification may be made. Each renewal shall be for a maximum of 60

The parent shall be consulted in determining the appropriate location for the provision of home instruction.</p> <p>If a parent repeatedly fails to make a student available for scheduled home instruction, the district board of education shall consider whether the student is truant in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:38-27 and proceed accordingly.</p>
